A participant may compete in only one singles competition and one doubles competition, 3. The condition for admission to the competition is possession of a current ICO license, 4. A category is created when minimum 4 participants, in doubles minimum 4 pairs, 5. With fewer entries in a category, a competitor will automatically be moved to another category, 6. If there is no possibility to move to another category and at least 3 players apply, half of the due ranking points will be counted, 7. Participants of the competition are obliged to present in the competition office signed statements regarding Rodo,
