Double Male U18, Double Female U18.
System o games	Depending on the number of entries, group play and a simple KO system.
Participation rules	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Entry limit: 80 players in singles/16 pairs in doubles in open/junior. A participant may only compete in one singles competition and one doubles competition. Admission to the competition is subject to possession of a current ICO licence. A category is created when min. 4 participants, in doubles min. 4 pairs. In the event of fewer entries in a category, the competitor will automatically be moved to another category. If it is not possible to move to another category and at least 3 players apply, half of the ranking points due shall be credited. If it is not possible to move to another category and at least 3 players have entered, half of the ranking points due will be credited. Participants of the competition are obliged to present in the competition office, signed statements required by the Organiser (downloadable forms available at www.ckis.pl or in the competition office).
